



## VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

- I agree to take part in Volunteer training as required, which will involve at least attending one online Volunteer induction, and preferably the face-to-face induction, before the Festival.
- I agree to carry out Volunteer tasks of at least 3 hours on a single day during the Festival - or more by arrangement.
- I agree to complete the tasks assigned to me by following instructions, or as directed by the Festival Organising Committee.
- I agree to contact the Festival Volunteer Coordinator as early as possible if circumstances prevent my commencing a shift.
- I agree that not completing my shift without ample notice could result in forfeiting my Festival Volunteer benefits.
- I agree that no financial payment will be made by Melbourne Ukulele Festival for my services as a Volunteer.
- I agree to wear my Melbourne Ukulele Festival lanyard whilst on duty.
- I agree to provide a responsible emergency contact with my application.
- I agree to the Melbourne Ukulele Festival ethos of accessibility and inclusivity, and I am prepared to work within that framework while volunteering for the Festival.
- I agree that the consumption of alcohol or other drugs will not impair my performance as a Volunteer at the Festival.
- I am over 18 years of age.
